

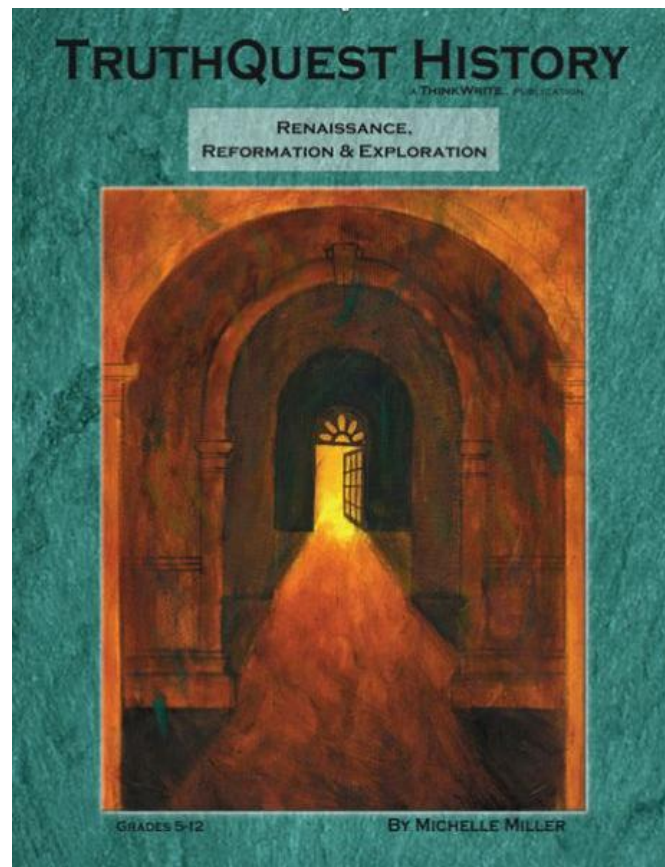

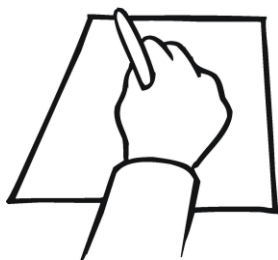
## **How do I use these notebooking pages with the *TruthQuest History* program?**
